On Wednesday, **May 6, 2009** North Carolina will once again honor its law enforcement community in a Peace Officers Memorial Day Ceremony. The purpose of this ceremony is to honor those law enforcement officers who have given their lives while serving the citizens of this State. This year's ceremony is sponsored by the NC Department of Justice and will be hosted by the Cabarrus County Sheriff's Office. The ceremony will be held at **Charity Baptist Church, 2420 Brantley Rd., Kannapolis, NC 28083** and will begin at 11:00 A.M.

An early morning coffee hour for families of Honor Roll officers, their escorts and program participants will be held beginning at 9:00 A.M. in the church fellowship hall.

Immediately following the ceremony, a luncheon will be held in the church fellowship hall for the Honor Roll officers' immediate families, law enforcement escorts and law enforcement agency heads.
